#### **Medicines in packaging**

The medication should also be in date – please check that this is the case before bringing it into school. All staff received their annual training on the use on epi-pen/auto injectors at the start of the term.

#### **Communication**

In our parent survey communication once again came out as a strength of the school. We will be continuing with our systems:

A **weekly bulletin** via ParentMail will be sent out every Thursday. Please ensure you have signed up for this. For those that do not have access to ParentMail, please request a hard copy from the office. The weekly bulletin contains timely information about events at the school and information for parents.

Class teachers will send out a **curriculum overview** at the start of each term. These will keep you informed as to the key topics that your child will be exploring for the term. These are in a new format this year and we hope you find them useful.

A half termly "**Shillington Lower Snapshot**" will be issued at the end of each half term to bring together and celebrate all the fantastic work that has been happening across the school.

Each child will be issued with a separate reading record and **home/school book**. This communication book is a two-way process; if you wish to write a comment to bring something to the class teacher's attention, please do so. The class teacher will also be recording in the book as appropriate. This book should not replace the on-going personal approach – if you wish to discuss anything with the class teacher or myself, please contact the office for our availability; a face-to-face discussion is often quicker to resolve/clarify any issues.
