Over the last 2 weeks in Phoenix Class, we have been looking at poetry. The children have been learning different poems and having a go at writing their own, using images to help them. In maths we have been digging into fractions and decimals as well as collecting and analysing data on a line graph. In DT, the children have designed and made their own silk screening templates which we will be putting to use on Monday next week!

SUN CREAM

As the weather warms up please ensure your child has had sun cream applied before attending school in the morning and has a sun hat with them.
