## **A Reminder of our Uniform**

Children should be sent to school clean, tidy and appropriately dressed. Long hair must be tied back. Shaved patterns in hair are not appropriate.

It is of great help if children have been taught to manage buttons, laces and zips before starting school.

On this site we have available logo jumpers/cardigans and logo white polo shirts. For PE the children are required to wear the logo red polo shirts. (Please note these are the compulsory items – there are several other items such as hats and bags available on the website which are optional.)

### **Pre-School Pixie Class**

Boys and Girls White logo or plain white polo shirt, scarlet round neck sweatshirt

### **Years R–4**

**Boys** grey trousers or tailored shorts, white logo polo shirt or plain white polo shirt, scarlet V-necked logo jumper, plain grey, black or white socks.

**Girls** grey skirt, pinafore dress, tailored shorts or trousers, white logo polo shirt or plain white polo shirt, scarlet V-necked logo jumper or cardigan, plain grey, black or white socks or grey, red or black plain tights. *In the summer term only red and white checked dresses may be worn.*

### **Footwear**

Sensible dark coloured shoes are preferred for both boys and girls. Trainers and open-toed sandals are not suitable. Children in Rainbows are also required to have a pair of Wellington boots in school. These should be clearly named and clipped together with a clothes peg.

### **PE & Games**

**Rainbows** black shorts, red logo polo PE t-shirt, plimsolls (summer term only).

**Years 1-4** black shorts, red logo polo PE t-shirt, plimsolls and trainers. In the winter a tracksuit or long sleeved top to be worn over shorts/t-shirt when outside.

The children will require shorts to be kept in school for use on indoor sports equipment (this is due to Health and Safety regulations).

Games and PE kit should be kept in a draw-string bag; this can be purchased from the school office.
